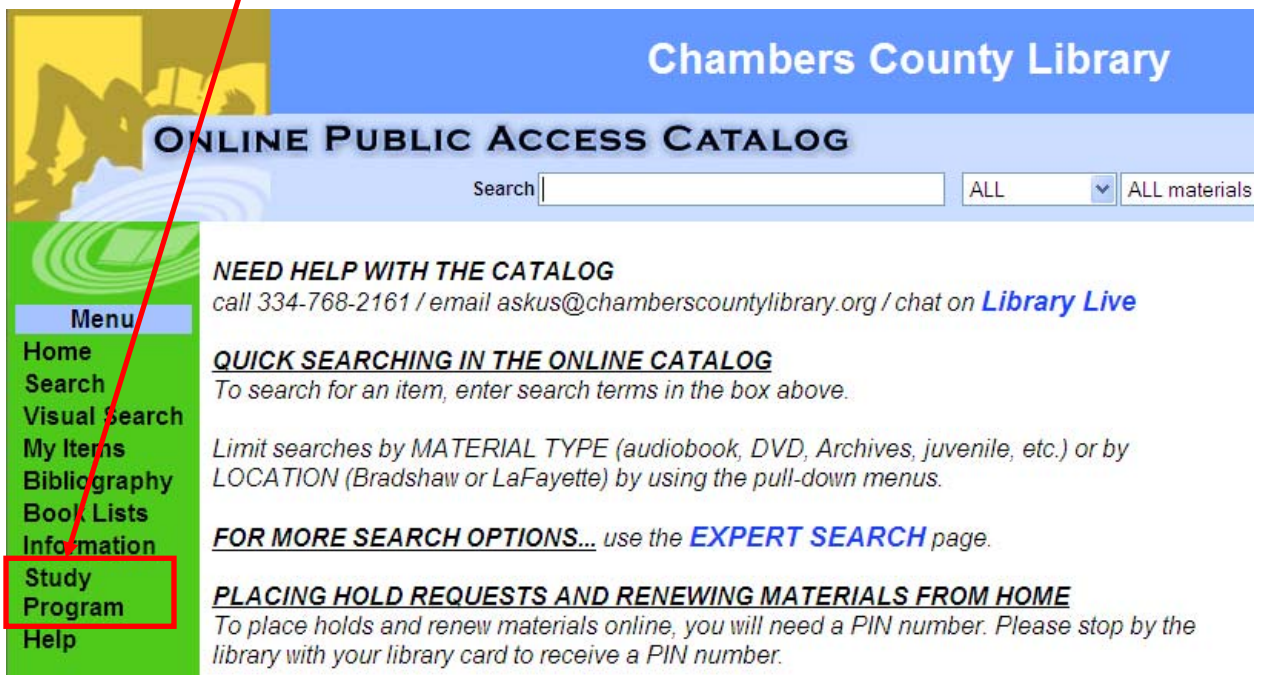

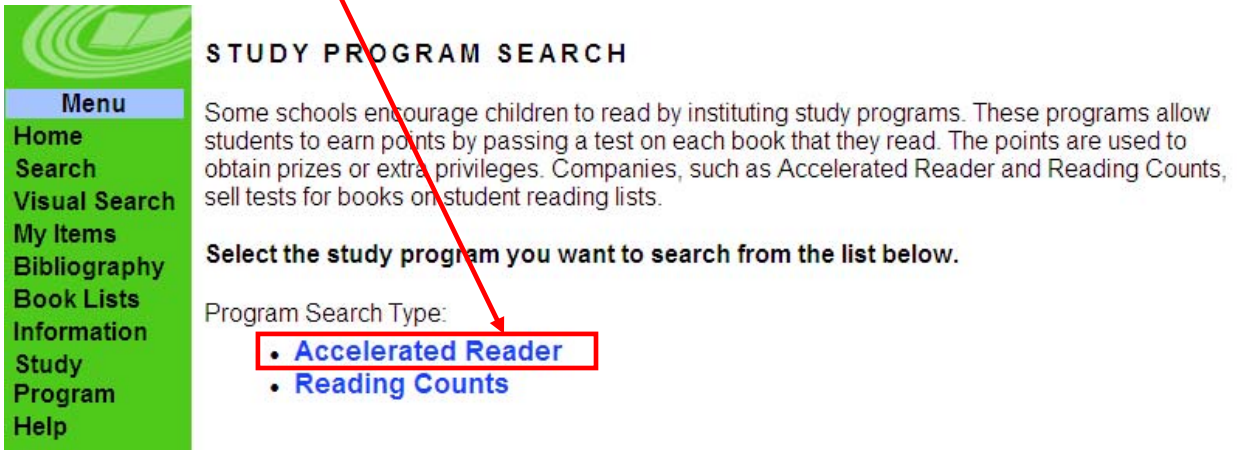
1. Go to the Library website at <http://www.chamberscountylibrary.org>
